Customer Acknowledge of Cross-Connection Control Requirements

A cross connection is any physical arrangement whereby water supply is connected, directly or Indirectly with any other water supply system, sewer, drain, conduit pool, storage reservoir, Plumbing fixture, or other waste or liquid of unknown or unsafe quality, which may be capable of imparting contamination to the public water supply as a result of backflow. Bypass arrangements, jumper connections, removable sections, swivel or changeover devices through which, or because of which, backflow could occur are considered to be cross-connections.

The Tennessee Safe Drinking Water Act of 1983 as described in Tennessee Code Annotated 68-221-701 through 720 requires that Claiborne Utilities District determine that no cross-connection exist or that the potential for cross-connection is protected by an appropriate Backflow Prevention Assembly for the purpose of insuring that the Public Water Supply does not become contaminated from backflow, due to a cross-connection.

The undersigned, shall cause no cross-connection, auxiliary intake, bypass, or interconnection to be made or allow one to exist for any purpose whatever unless the construction and operation of same have been approved by the Tennessee Department of Public Health, and the operation of such cross-connection, auxiliary intake by-pass, or interconnection arrangement has been inspected and approved by Claiborne Utilities District or its representative. You will be mailed a notice requesting that you have your Backflow Prevention Assembly tested. Instructions for the test and reporting requirements will be included with notice.
